Discussion on Benchmarking Perspectives

Presented by Randy Simons

Following the AQN Annual Meeting, Mr. Simons will introduce you to the basics of benchmarking including the basic process steps, selection of peer groups, and the four typical perspectives of comparison. To reinforce learnings, he will walk through a real-life example of how to apply these benchmarking techniques and discuss the results of each analysis.

Results of these comparisons allow organizations to develop plans on how to make improvements or adapt specific best practices with the aim of increasing some aspect of performance.
